That certain other guarantees of the US Constitution, namely equal protection and etc., combine with the basic right to custody, and provide the legal right to totally equal and fully shared (that is, joint legal *and* joint physical) custody for *both* of the divorced, separated, or unwed parents?

That all of the above has been consistently upheld by the United States Supreme Court for well over one hundred years, in many, many, many of their official rulings, even to the present day?

That the judges of state "family" courts are breaking those laws *every day of the week*, when they use "best interest", or any other excuse, to "award" custody to only one of the parents?

That starting on September 17, 2004, legally educated noncustodials began filing federal class action lawsuits all over America, in order to hold states responsible, and restore those rights?

That there are state and county coordinators who can provide you with the simple papers to join your state's class action lawsuit - and, also, that there is absolutely no cost for you to join it?

That there are thousands of people fighting for your equal rights? That they need your voice?
